Infrastructure

"An epitome of Serenity"- The NIAM campus is spread in a lush green area of 32 acres. Its state of art infrastructure provides students with all modern amenities providing a perfect platform which facilitates the learning process. The buildings have been named after rivers which symbolize free flow of thoughts, dreams and ideas and their confluence at a junction called "NIAM".

Academic Block-Brahmaputra

Brahmaputra is the gateway to entire NIAM activities such as lectures, panel discussion, and a forum of professional meets. It houses a warm reception, administrative offices, the PGDABM cell, smart class rooms, library, computer centres and a conference hall.



Smart-Class Room

Smart Class room is equipped with high speed data communication network and conference facility. The classrooms are air-conditioned and equipped with multimedia audio-visual amenities like Inter-White board, Touch Screen podium, Motion Reader, Computer, Recording facilities and LCD projectors, Closed Circuit television facility, etc. provide effective learning. Each class room is provided with internet and intranet facilities.

Computer Centre

The institute is equipped with 2 computer centres which have more than 100 desktops with 24 hours internet support that are connected with high-speed LAN of 4 MBPS leased lines and whole campus is Wi-Fi enabled.

It includes more than 12000 books, 4500 periodicals, 15 newspapers, 16 video-tapes, 30 photographic albums, 165 CDs and floppies, 500 bound volumes and 9 electronic databases along with database support through CMIE- Prowess, Indiastat, Proquest database.

PGDABM is a fully residential programme. The hostel have 120 plus single occupancy rooms with Wi-Fi connectivity. The rooms are well furnished, with separate phone lines, air cooler/ACs and attached washrooms. The hostel is provided with newspapers and weekly, fortnightly and monthly publications.

Infotainer- Forum of Discussion

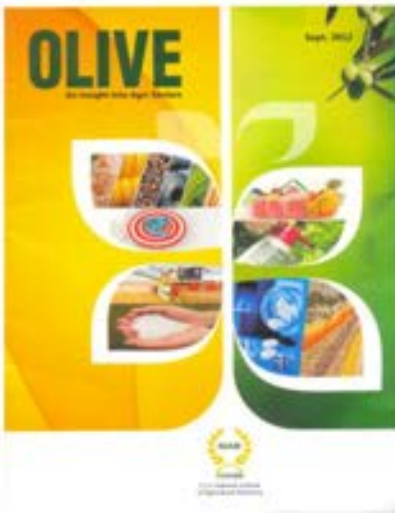
